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APPLICATION FOR ADMISSIONS STUDENT STANDARD OF CONDUCT

Upon entering school, students are expected to maintain the highest standards of integrity, honesty, and morality. Further development of responsible behavior is a basic tenet of the Standard of Conduct pledge. Students will exhibit a good appearance at all times. Both dress and behavior should exemplify the highest standards of Christian example. Students should exercise good taste and dress appropriately. A person's conduct should never be an embarrassment to others.

A **Standard of Conduct** based on the following Biblical imperative is necessary to provide an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us. The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well being. A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led WCCA to adopt the following standards which it is believed are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student. **The school, therefore, requires:**

Students of Warriors for Christ Christian Academy are expected to refrain from talking about or engaging in cheating, swearing, vulgar language, violence, and using narcotics. Students who participate in or discuss such activities at school are subject to suspension. Students are expected to act in an orderly and respectful manner, maintaining Biblical standards of social courtesy, moral behavior, acceptable language, and honesty. Students must agree to strive toward unquestionable character in dress, conduct, and attitude.

Warriors for Christ Christian Academy encourage students and parents to exercise utmost discretion in a student's choice of entertainment. We know you want quality character training, and if it is to be achieved, as many negative influences as possible must be eliminated. "... fill your minds with those things that are good and that deserve praise: things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, and honorable." Philippians 4:8.

Behavior. Students are to act in an orderly and fashionable manner while in the Learning Center. Students must maintain self-control and self-discipline in following the Learning Center Rules.

Courtesy. Christians are supposed to treat everyone with the proper respect, and are to show proper deference to those in authority. Therefore, students are expected to maintain Biblical standards of social courtesy and moral behavior. Such conduct as talking back, sarcasm addressed to those in authority, complaining, and gossiping will not be tolerated and are punishable with Disciplinary Notifications up to expulsion.

Cheating. Cheating in the end cheats the cheater. Anyone caught cheating must repeat that PACE at the expense of the parent and is an automatic suspension.. Re-admission of the student after suspension will be at the discretion of the administration.

Stealing. Stealing is taking anything that does not belong to you. This includes "borrowing without permission." Any students caught stealing will be required to replace items and/or money, and will be subject to suspension, at the discretion of the administration.

Vandalism. All property of Warriors for Christ Christian Academy and/or St Paul Baptist Church is to be treated as God's property. **Vandalism of any type will not be tolerated.** Any student vandalizing school or church property will be held responsible for its replacement costs, including any labor and other associated charges. The administration reserves the right to take further action against any student vandalizing the school and/or the church's property, including but not limited to disciplinary action and filing criminal charges.

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APPLICATION FOR ADMISSIONS STUDENT STANDARD OF CONDUCT (continued)

Language. Students should not only refrain from cursing and using the Lord's name in vain, but also refrain from vulgar and slang expressions which are offensive.

Inappropriate Physical Contact. ANY inappropriate physical conduct will not be tolerated at school or school functions.

Public displays of affection are prohibited on Warriors for Christ Christian Academy campus and at school functions. Inappropriate physical contact includes hand-holding, hugging between "boyfriends" and "girlfriends", kissing, or any contact which the Warriors for Christ Christian Academy staff deems inappropriate. Disciplinary action will be taken at the discretion of the administration.

Physical contact of a rough or violent nature (pushing, shoving, tripping, hitting, fighting) will receive disciplinary action depending on the severity of contact, at the discretion of the administration.

Any student observing any harmful situation should immediately discuss the matter with a supervisor.

This Standard of Conduct reflects the philosophy of WCCA of excellent education without compromising the Word of God. Students are strongly encouraged to be sure they understand what the Standard of Conduct expects, and be sure they want to follow the lifestyle presented in the Standard of Conduct. WCCA administrators are serious about upholding their part. When students and parents sign the Standard of Conduct, they are accepting the principles expressed. These principles are not considered negotiable.

The selection of the restrictions mentioned in the pledge may appear arbitrary to some; but while not condemning others who see differently, WCCA believes that the restrictions named are outstanding types of conduct that are detrimental to the student's spiritual growth, which is our objective. Students found to be out of harmony with the WCCA ideals of life may be invited to withdraw when the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct.

Dear WCCA Parent: All students are required to read and sign the Standard of Conduct. A parental signature is also necessary. This slip is to be turned into the office. It is mandatory that this form be signed and returned in order to continue enrollment. Failure to comply will result in student dismissal. If a child is unable to read it is the parent's responsibility to go over and explain if necessary the Standard of Conduct.
